BEHAVIOR AGREEMENT

The WLHS Substance-Free Grad Party 2018 is put on and chaperoned by parent volunteers. It is NOT a WLHS sponsored function. To ensure the success of this annual event, the following behavior will need to be followed. Your signature indicates compliance with this agreement.

1. This is a substance-free event. This means NO alcoholic beverages, cigarettes or drugs will be tolerated.

2. This event is ONLY open to WLHS Seniors.

3. To ensure the success of this event and our student's safety, the location of this event is TOP SECRET.

4. Seniors are REQUIRED to ride the buses to and from the event. Buses will depart from the Chiles Center at approximately 10:20 pm following the graduation ceremony. Students will be returned to WLHS at approximately 5:00 am on Wednesday, June 6.

5. Seniors will be REQUIRED to remain at the party's venue throughout the ENTIRE event.

6. Any inappropriate, disrespectful behavior, profanity, indecent exposure, violence, threats of violence, damage to property, injury to self or others, or use of alcohol, cigarettes and/or drugs will NOT be tolerated. If this does occur, parent will be contacted, regardless of the time, and will need to pick up their child.

7. Attire: casual (change out of your dressy graduation clothes before you board the buses, give your clothes to your parents).

8. NOT ALLOWED: Cell phones, cameras, Mp3 players, electronics of any kind, purses, valuables, hair dryers, hair products, cap and gown, extra clothes, etc. There will NOT be a secure area to store anything of value. All items not allowed, will be confiscated immediately, so empty all pockets.

9. NOTE: Wristbands will be used as proof of Grad Party registration and will be attached on students' wrists during the morning of the Graduation Rehearsal. It is IMPERATIVE that students wear this band all day. ONLY students with wristbands on will be allowed onto the buses for the Grad Party.

10. Students requiring medication as listed on their Medical Form should label and place their meds in a small ziploc bag. The bag will be turned in on the morning of rehearsal when the student picks up their wristband. The Grad Party committee will hold these bags until the event when they will be given back to the student. Please note that these bags will be checked and any items that are not allowed as identified under #8 will be confiscated.

11. NOTE: All chaperones will have cell phones. If students need to contact parents during the event, it can be done.

12. For safety, students should NOT drive themselves home. WLHS will not allow seniors to leave their cars overnight in the parking lots. Parents will be expected to pick up students at the high school @ 5:00AM.
